Procedure in Detail: After the patient consented, he was placed on the fluoroscopic table in the prone position. Standard monitoring consisting of blood pressure, EKG, pulse oximeter and end tidal CO₂ were applied. Intravenous line with angiocath 20g was inserted and intravenous sedation consisting of Versed and Propofol was titrated to effect. The skin was prepped with betadine and draped with a fenestrated drape. The skin was anesthetized with Lidocaine 1% using a #25g needle. Under fluoroscopic guidance with oblique view, the superior articular process of levels _____ Bilateral Right Left were identified. Right extra-pedicular approach with a # 22g needle with a # 18g introducer was directed into the disc into levels _____ Bilateral Right Left. These middle placements were checked in AP and lateral view.
