Under fluoroscopic guidance, using a translaminar approach and intrathecal injection of non-ionic contrast was made without difficulty or complication. Plain film radiographs were obtained in the AP, lateral and both oblique projections. The patient was then transported to the CT suite for dual helical images. In addition, multiplanar reconstruction (MPR) images were made. The patient tolerated the procedure well and left the surgery suite in satisfactory condition with post-procedural instructions provided.
